Unfortunately the VAFFC does not care about what is right for Richmond for they only care what is the best for profits.

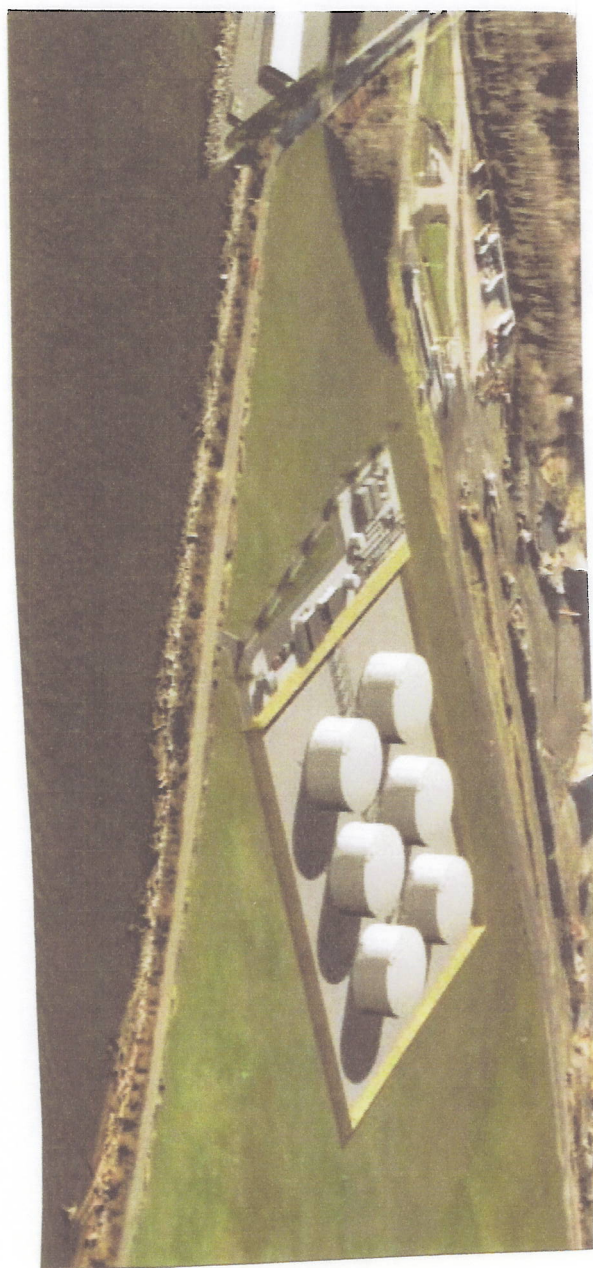
Option #3 provided by the VAFFC
