Re: The Future of Garden City Lands

I, Barry, Grabowski, support the Garden City Lands development partners application to the Agricultural Land Commission to have the Garden City Lands (the "Lands") removed from the Agricultural Land Reserve (the "ALR"). I have worked and lived in Richmond for 20 years.

If Lands are removed from the ALR, the City of Richmond will obtain the certainty of having ownership of 50% of the Lands and input into the development of the remaining Lands, as contemplated by the Memorandum of Understanding between the City, Canada Lands Company and the Musqueam Band (the "MOU"). The application to remove the Lands from the ALR is not in and of itself a determination of how the Lands will be used if removed from the ALR. If the City of Richmond owns some of the Lands, this at least ensures that the citizens of Richmond will have a voice in how those portions of the Lands are used.

If the Lands are not removed from the ALR, the MOU will expire and the City of Richmond will not have any ownership interest, unless a different interest can be negotiated. Given that the Musqueam Band would still have an interest in the Lands after expiration of the MOU, either by virtue of their claims to the Lands as ancestral lands or by virtue of their beneficial interest in the Lands held by the Canada Land Company, there would seem to be little reason for the Musqueam Band to relinquish any of that interest to the City of Richmond. At least not the same percentage of the Lands, and not for the price that the City of Richmond would pay under the MOU.

I don't believe that removing the Lands from the ALR automatically means that the Lands will not be used for some form of agricultural purpose, even if that purpose is restricted to some form of urban gardens. However, in response to those opposing this application on the basis that it is agricultural land that can be cultivated, my personal observation is that if it were economically viable to farm the Lands, they would be under some form of cultivation already. However, given the current status of the title to the Lands, any discussion of the agricultural uses of the Lands is theoretical at best.

Please count my voice as being in support of the application to remove the Lands from the Agricultural Land Reserve.

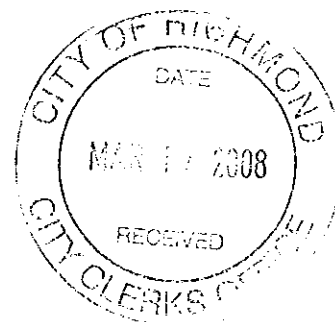
The Garden City agreement offers many benefits for Richmond, including:

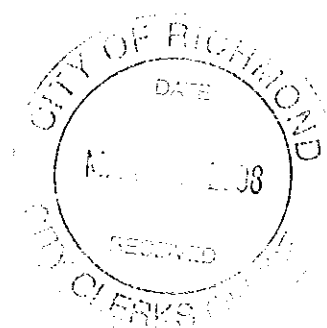

To whom it may concern,
 I wonder if the respondents to the poll were aware that the Richmond Nature Park is very near to the Garden City lands. It has been in existence for many years, and borders Westminster Highway, Shell Road, No. 5 Road and Alderbridge Way (I believe). It is more brown than "green", and consists to a greater degree of the native bushes, shrubs and trees of the area. Not that there is anything wrong with it, but to be really enjoyed, one has to go deep into the trails, rather than just casually walk through it. What is the rationale of having another park in close vicinity to this one, unless it is radically different? Moreover, between the Garden City lands and the Richmond Nature Park, there is another block of government land of similar terrain and plant content bordered by Westminster Highway, No. 4 Road, Shell Road and Alderbridge Way, which may be viewed as "surplus" as well. It is east of the Garden City lands. Furthermore, Garden City Community Park exists north of the Garden City lands, and there is forested land east of the Richmond Nature Park bordered by Westminster Highway to the south, Highway 99 to the west and the Richmond Auto Mall to the east. I'm sending this e-mail as my personal submission to the Public Hearings on the Garden City lands.

Richmond is a vital, growing city. It is facing pressures of growth, just like every other city in the lower mainland. However, because its growth is being managed well based on the principles of sustainability, any opportunity to increase Richmond's green belt and parkland, based on an assured outcome, should be utilized.

That's why I believe that the only decision that Council should make regarding the Garden City lands – and the only decision the ALC should make – is to exclude the lands from the ALR, thereby permitting the City of Richmond to develop nearly half of the land for public park and recreation amenities, and control the development of the Musqueam Nation lands under the City's zoning bylaws. This is the only way to ensure that the City has at least half of the Garden City lands as public park and other amenities. This will provide the certainty of green belt development the City needs for this area.

I have every confidence in Council that it will allow the public to have a say in how the City's land uses will be developed in the Garden City area – and how the Musqueam Nation lands will be developed.


I am opposed to the exclusion for the GardenCity Lands from the ALR. I am a member of the sport community I have coached Soccer in Richmond for over 8 years. It is important to note that the Chair of the Sports Council Mr. Jim Lamond, does not speak for all of the sports community in Richmond on this issue. There has been no discussions among the participants at all levels in the sports community in Richmond about it. What is reasonable to conclude from Mr. Lamonds comments, is that as Chair, he supports any measure that would provide additional sports facilities in Richmond.

That is the mandate of the Sports council in Richmond. A more appropriate question to ask Mr. Lamond would be, does Richmond need more grass sporting facilities on the Gardern City land, or more money to convert existing grass sports fields in Richmond, to all weather fields. I believe not only Mr. Lamond, but the entire sporting community in Richmond would answer that any money would be better spent on upgrading existing fields to all weather, rather than add additional grass fields. The sports council and community have done an admirable job in cooperation with the city to vastly improve the number and quality of facilities in Richmond. Take for example the all weather soccer fields. It was pointed out by the Richmond soccer association, that after the next two all weather fields are completed, all of the soccer players, of all ages in Richmond, will be able to play all of their practices and Richmond games, on all weather fields.

I do not believe that removing the Garden City lands from the ALR is in either Richmond or British Columbia's best interest. The ALR was set up specifically for agricultural areas in jepardy such as the Garden City lands. The MOU offers a very limited short term gain, for a substancial long term loss to both Richmond, and British Columbia, and to suggest that this unique jewel of agricultural land should be covered with highrise concrete towers, so that a couple of playing fields may be built, is absurd.

It needs to be pointed out that the issue for the sports community in Richmond is not lack of land. But lack of funding to turn the present land into day and evening, 12 month a year facilities. Each all weather field that is constructed in Richmond on predesignated grass sports fields, frees up many times the same amount of grass fields. This is due to the fact that the grass fields can only be played upon for a small fraction of the day, each day, before they degenerate to mud.

It is time to take a thoughtfull long term look at the real cost of removing the Garden City Lands from the ALR, and not get distracted by flashy flyers, and 10 second quotes.

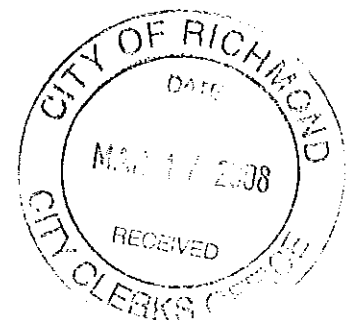

I am opposed to the request to remove the 'Garden City Lands' from the Agricultural Land Reserve (ALR). I do so for the following reasons:

- The rapid growth in the core area of Richmond on existing land should be sufficient to meet demand.
- Not all demand needs to be met
- All infrastructure to support the rapid growth in available housing, therefore population needs to be addressed. By this I mean schools, roads, hospital beds, fire department equipment/fire halls, etc, in my opinion are not being adequately addressed
- Richmond should show leadership in planning and providing these necessary services before the influx of people.
- We don't need a code 'orange' at Richmond Hospital to remind us of poor planning due to excess growth with proper & timely infrastructure growth
- A significant portion of the lands should be farmed, if possible. If the land is unusable for meaningful & profitable farming, as decided by a "reasonableness" test by an expert in agriculture, Then alternative farming methods should be pursued but on a smaller portion of land. I would say 60% of what they had.

I'm not clear anymore what position the First Nations play in this process but I can't see them arguing over a well planned growth strategy that also focuses on parks and agriculture, as well as some development, once the city & Province do their due diligence concerning all necessary public services.

Again based on a lost understanding of legal land ownership issues as the result of land claim, in the alternative, since the land claim has been settled do the First Nations own the vast majority and this is our only window to get anything? Is it really get something now versus nothing later?

I moved to BC from Quebec in 1971 and have lived in Richmond since then. I have seen transform itself many times, as it is once more. I wish to submit my opinion on the proposed application to remove these lands from the ALR. I am vehemently opposed to this application for many reasons. I have outlined these in the following:

1. **First Nations Claim to land**- with all due respect to Mr. Campbell, I find his rhetoric appalling. I did not expect anything else from the Musquem leader. The continual lining up at the trough for this group is disappointing. To state that their people have a claim to these lands is a matter yet to be decided. On a practical level I would suggest that the First Natives had no claim to this land. Pre dykes, Richmond was no more than a bog or swamp. For Mr. Campbell to state that his people have rights and wandered or picnicked here is a stretch. He should be quite pleased with the amount of land and valuations of their settlements thus far. On a pro rata basis, his constituents are multi millionaires. Enough is enough!

For Richmond council to even consider that any of these lands should be given to First Nations is a disgrace. I am more than prepared to "gamble" and see what the courts decide here. But to simply acquiesce once again to the demands of this special interest group because it is the "easy route" is appalling. I have no interest in using my hard earned tax dollars to further their wealth. My goodness, what an outcome for First Nations this would be.....half of the Garden City Lands for development next to green space. Talk about a windfall for them. Unacceptable. Finally on this point, if you are truly worried about the court ruling and that we could lose all rights to the land, who cares! The last time I checked, the city controls zoning. Let the Musquem get control....the land can sit as a wonderful example to all as a community not willing to bend and jeopardize the rights and future of their citizens for the profit of a select few who do not even live in our community.

2. **The future of Richmond**- the current application lacks any foresight and vision. This council has a unique opportunity and one that future councils will never have again. You have a chance to impact the lives of all residents in a powerful positive way. I do not have the exact stats for our community growth but I do believe that Richmond is growing significantly perhaps as much as 50% over the coming decades. Where is our Park? At best, Richmond had green spaces or green belts. We do not have a park of meaning. We have a bunch of small green belts, none of which attract its citizens the likes of a Stanley Park. What a wonderful

opportunity the Garden City Lands have presented Richmond with.

Gamble that the courts and Federal government will do the right thing here. To state that we could lose all the land is typical fear mongering by politicians and special interests. I am not a lawyer but a business man. I suggest that to once again award Musquem more land before their claims are settled is not appropriate. What is the worst thing that can happen....we lose the land and it gets developed. The best thing though is remarkable. We do not need another cluster of high-rises next to yet another "green space".

What Richmond needs is a wonderful example of "livability" in the form of a large park setting for all families and visitors to enjoy. We could call it "Citizens Park". I know the support for such a thing would be enormous from the business community as well.

3. **Who controls what happens with land?** Perhaps I lack insight on this matter. Is it not the City of Richmond that will have ultimate say in what can be build on this space if the land was ever to be removed from the ALR? If that is in fact the case, the risk is very low that we would lose the land to development. What it takes is Strength, Vision and Wisdom to only consider proposals that will enhance the livability of our city.

I cannot believe that any one of you believe that this current application makes sense for our future. If you vote for this, it shows you took the easy route and once again fell victim to rhetoric and lack the skill set necessary to shape our community. If our population doubles in the next 75 years, where will the children play? How livable will Richmond be?

I will speak in terms perhaps you can understand.....politics is always about power. If you vote for exclusion, this will spell the end of your power. You can bet, citizens will be disgusted on this issue and votes will be few at the next election. I will certainly do my part (as a fairly active and aware citizen) to ensure that any councilor who supports this application will not be get elected again.

I implore council to show wisdom here. Now is a time to show you have Vision and believe Progress is not defined with high-rises and increases to the tax base. Thank you for meeting with Trustees and district staff to discuss the City Centre Area Plan and more specifically the demographics study that was undertaken by the City of Richmond. This information was very helpful to the Board of Education when it considered its capital budget submission to the Ministry of Education. Under separate letter we have forwarded to you the approved capital budget submission that includes the following city centre capital project requests:

- expansion of the Tomsett Elementary School Site
- expansion of the Talmey Elementary School Site
- addition of a new elementary school site in the city centre area

We believe that this will accommodate the long-term accommodation needs for elementary aged students in the city centre area. With respect to the accommodation of secondary aged students, we believe that approximately 2,000 spaces could be created within the three existing secondary schools i.e. Cambie, Richmond and MacNeill Secondary Schools.

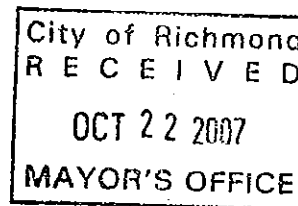
- Cambie Secondary School may require a 500 seat addition
