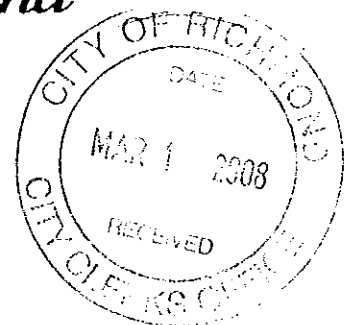

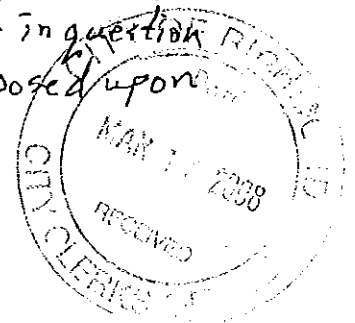

I am the son of Musqueam members Delbert & Frances Guerin (nee Point). My mother's branch of my family were the most recent Musqueam members to reside at q'waga'y^w (Garry Pt./Steveston). They had traditional big-houses there and only moved to Musqueam IR#2 during the 1950's at the insistence of the Indian agent for New Westminster District and under threat of the revocation of their recognized Indian status. That was, effectually, disassociation from a significant part of their ancestral home. Return of the lands in question is one step toward reconciliation of wrongs imposed upon our people at the hands of colonial authority.

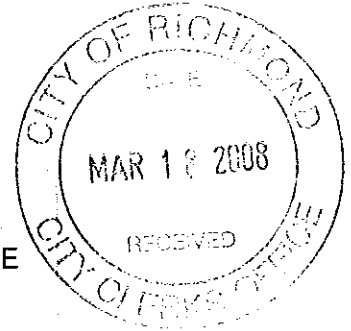

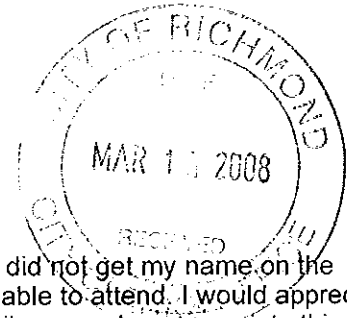

Sometimes representing the Richmond Sports Council, the Richmond Soccer Alliance, the Richmond Girls Soccer Association, but today representing my family.

3 points, very simple.

1. Council should continue with the ALC exclusion application. The City can do nothing without having ownership of the lands, or part of them. Richmond doesn't own any of the lands today - one cannot "lose" anything they do not already have. Nobody's wishes can be accommodated if we don't own any of the land. Richmond has tried for generations to get this done. Please get it done this time.
2. Many people have started their presentations with 5 words "I'm not an expert, but....." and proceeded to throw out uneducated opinions on legal, technical and societal issues. This is their right and I respect that. However, on the key question of whether the GCL is suitable for farming, we have heard two undeniable experts - Mr. Zylmans and Mr. Jones - lifetime Richmond farmers, the people quoted in the newspapers every year about food farming in Richmond. Both indicated the lands are not suitable for farming, and that neither they nor their farming associates would want the lands for farming. That expert advice good enough for me.
3. The public hearing process should be revisited in the future by whatever legal requirements are necessary. Time limits should be used and enforced for applicants and the public. It is insulting to those who have waited for days to speak to listen to ridiculously long and repetitive presentations. Council is to be applauded for their commitment to and patience with the current process. It is the process itself that should change.

- My name is Steven Chen. I am Sales Manager for the North Vancouver Hotel. I am speaking on behalf of North Vancouver Hotel.
- The Richmond community, including North Vancouver Hotel, has long sought to achieve ownership of these lands for the benefit of all our citizens and businesses. This negotiated agreement provides the only viable route for the City of Richmond to have a role in the future of the Garden City Lands. But we must first ensure that the land comes out of the ALR. Once this occurs it will allow the City of Richmond the opportunity to purchase its 50 percent share of the land for public use such as parks, trails, community gardens and gathering places. Creating a City that will be attractive to residents and visitors alike.
- The land is currently sitting vacant and has been vacant for many years.
- If the Memorandum of Understanding remains in place, any development by the City, Canada Lands Company and Musqueam First Nation on Garden City Lands must still go through provincial and municipal land use approval processes, integrate with the Official Community Plan and comply with city zoning bylaws. We will still have many more opportunities to express our views on the future use of this land through the public process. And North Vancouver Hotel will continue to support this process and we encourage our Mayor, Council and City staff to continue striving to have this land removed from the ALR so we can all move forward in promoting Richmond as a sustainable, livable and excited destination to visit.

Dear Mayor and Councillors:

I am concerned about the current status of the Garden City Lands, and am writing to let the City of Richmond know that I strongly oppose the City's block application to remove the Garden City Lands from the Agricultural Land Reserve (ALR).

This is something that concerns me deeply. Green spaces and proximity to nature are prized elements in any living environment. Richmond needs to hold on to its green spaces, and resist the lure of short-term profit from selling land to developers. The vast expanses of pavement and sprawling shopping complexes are not things that make me proud of my city, and I am concerned to think Council is considering pursuing more development on such a large undeveloped block. The traffic, congestion and pollution in the downtown core are already too high.

I am even more concerned about the possible removal of these lands from the ALR when I think about food security in the future. Today, much of our food is imported. There are several factors which may seriously impinge on the ability of residents of Richmond and BC to access or produce enough food in the future: climate change, fuel scarcity (or at the least ever-increasing fuel prices), and new initiatives to convert possible food sources into fuel (e.g. biofuels, corn-based ethanol, etc.). At this moment, none of us can predict the extent of these issues' impact on where our food is grown and how we can obtain it, but I think we can agree that there is uncertainty. In the face of such risks, I as a citizen expect that my governments make plans for such uncertainties and develop policies to protect the collective good.

Removing the Garden City Lands from the ALR will not only be a permanent loss for the City of Richmond, but it will set a dangerous precedent for removing other still-undeveloped lands across the province. We have already lost so much arable land to urbanization and development: we must protect the land still left. I would love to see Richmond become a leader both in developing sustainable agricultural practices as well as innovative ways of combining agricultural and urban activities side-by-side. As a thriving urban centre with many active farms within our city itself, we are ideally positioned to take on such a leadership role. That would be a legacy of which our councillors and city planners could feel justly proud.

The creation of the ALR is an example of government taking a long-range view: bravo for that! Our governments - at all levels - must think about the collective good and interests of all residents of Richmond, and BC, for the long term. As our elected officials, you must imagine what will be best for Richmond for generations to come, not just between now and the next election. Please, make the prudent choice: vote to keep the Garden City Lands in the ALR. This is also the choice which challenges you, and all of us, to creatively define new opportunities and paths towards a sustainable future. I look forward to Richmond embarking on such a civic project. Thank you for your time.

It's very simple, more residential towers will bring more people on the roads. The recent carbon tax would not change much of driving behavior of those who need to drive to work, school, etc.

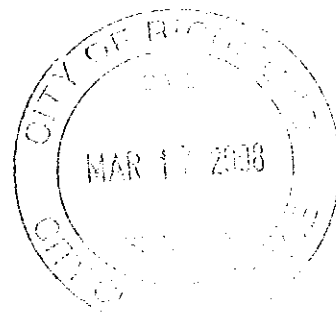
Traffic congestion in Richmond is a huge problem. I know city council and the Mayor are working hard on this issue, but it looks like it's not enough.
