#### **Staff Report**

#### Origin

At the June 13, 2016 Council meeting, the following resolution was approved:

That the City of Richmond participate in the 11<sup>th</sup> China (Zhengzhou) International Garden Expo and Park Design exchange with the City of Zhengzhou, China as detailed in the staff report titled, "Participation in the 11<sup>th</sup> China (Zhengzhou) International Garden Expo," dated May 18, 2016, from the Senior Manager, Parks.

The purpose of this report is to seek Council's approval for a Richmond City Council elected official representative and one City Staff person to attend the Opening Ceremony of the 11<sup>th</sup> China International Garden Exposition in Zhengzhou, China, in September 2017.

This report supports Council's 2014-2018 Term Goal #2 A Vibrant, Active and Connected City:

Continue the development and implementation of an excellent and accessible system of programs, services, and public spaces that reflect Richmond's demographics, rich heritage, diverse needs, and unique opportunities, and that facilitate active, caring, and connected communities.

2.3. Outstanding places, programs and services that support active living, wellness and a sense of belonging.

This report supports Council's 2014-2018 Term Goal #5 Partnerships and Collaboration:

Continue development and utilization of collaborative approaches and partnerships with intergovernmental and other agencies to help meet the needs of the Richmond community.

5.2. Strengthened strategic partnerships that help advance City priorities.

#### Analysis

On June 13, 2016, Council approved Richmond's participation in the 11<sup>th</sup> China (Zhengzhou) International Garden Expo and park design exchange with the City of Zhengzhou, China. Since approval of the reciprocal park design exchange with Zhengzhou, the project has proceeded. The City of Richmond park design for installation in Zhengzhou, China, is complete and is now currently under construction for a total value of \$1.0M CAD in China. All costs with the construction of the Richmond designed park (Attachment 1) are being realised by the Expo Organizers in Zhengzhou.

On May 16, 2017, a delegation from Zhengzhou, led by their Mayor, visited Richmond and was greeted at City Hall where a formal Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between Richmond and Zhengzhou was signed by the Acting Mayor of Richmond and the Mayor of Zhengzhou. Following the signing ceremony, the delegation toured the reciprocal park site (Aberdeen Park located at Brown Road and Cambie Road) that Zhengzhou will be designing a portion of in

Richmond. During the visit, the City of Richmond was invited by the City of Zhengzhou and Expo Organizers to attend the Expo and visit the Richmond designed garden.

#### International Garden Exposition Opening Ceremonies – Official Invitation

Attachment 2 is a formal invitation from the Zhengzhou Expo organizing committee inviting the City of Richmond to attend the formal Expo Opening Ceremonies in September 2017 in Zhengzhou, China. Attendance at the Expo will continue to further strengthen the relationship between Richmond and Zhengzhou, and also permit face to face discussions regarding the upcoming Zhengzhou design of a portion of Richmond's Aberdeen Park, as per the terms of the MOU between both cities. From a best practice perspective, the Expo will provide an excellent opportunity to engage with cities from across the world and discuss and experience the many internationally designed landscapes. The 11<sup>th</sup> China (Zhengzhou) International Garden Expo is scheduled to run from September 2017 to May 2018, after which time the Expo grounds are expected to be converted into a park.

#### **Financial Impact**

It is anticipated that the cost of travel for one member of Richmond City Council and one City Staff person is \$15,000, and subject to Council approval, be funded from the Council Contingency Fund.

#### Conclusion

The City of Richmond's participation in the 11<sup>th</sup> China (Zhengzhou) International Garden Exposition will further develop goodwill between Richmond, China and Zhengzhou. Through the exchange of design ideas, this initiative continues to create an enhanced cultural understanding for the participants, and park legacies will be created both in China and Richmond.
