## Staff Report

## Origin

Under the *Community Charter* and the Council Procedure Bylaw No. 7560, Council must provide for advance public notice of Council and Committee meetings. Accordingly, the 2023 Council meeting schedule was adopted on November 14, 2022.

This report supports Council's Strategic Plan 2022-2026 Focus Area #1 Proactive in Stakeholder and Civic Engagement:

1.3 Increase the reach of communication and engagement efforts to connect with Richmond's diverse community.

#### **Analysis**

## The National Day for Truth and Reconciliation

On March 9, 2023, British Columbia formally adopted the *National Day for Truth and Reconciliation Act* (Bill 2) which amends the *Employment Standards Act* and introduces a new statutory holiday to be observed annually on September 30<sup>th</sup> as a day to commemorate the history and legacy of the residential school system.

This year, September 30<sup>th</sup> will fall on a Saturday and observance of the day will fall on Monday, October 2<sup>nd</sup>. Currently, a General Purposes Committee and a Finance Committee meeting is scheduled for Monday, October 2<sup>nd</sup>. In order to accommodate observance of the holiday, staff propose that the General Purposes Committee and Finance Committee meeting be moved to October 3<sup>rd</sup> and the Planning Committee meeting currently scheduled for October 3<sup>rd</sup> be moved to October 4<sup>th</sup>, as presented in the adjusted meeting schedule (Attachment 1).

Adjustments will only be limited to the 2023 Council meeting schedule and future Council meeting schedules will incorporate observance of the holiday accordingly.

It is recommended that the amended 2023 Council and Committee meeting schedule be approved as shown in Attachment 1. The approval of the adjusted meeting schedule at this time provides Council and the public with advance notice of the October 2023 meeting schedule.
