Staff Report

Origin

Brett Mortensen started his employment with the City of Richmond as a Tree Preservation Official for the purposes of bylaw enforcement on July 17, 2006.

Analysis

It would be appropriate during his investigations to provide the City's Tree Preservation Official with

- the ability to request personal information such as names and addresses;
- the ability to maintain continuity of the investigation and integrity of any evidence gathered;
- the ability to serve Court documents; and
- the ability to issue, as permitted, Municipal Ticket Information forms for infractions.

Under provisions of the Offence Act, for the purposes of the issuance of a violation ticket and / or service of summons in respect of an alleged offence under a bylaw of a Municipality, a Peace Officer includes Bylaw Enforcement Officers as appointed under the Police Act.

Financial Impact

None.

Conclusion

It is recommended that Council authorize the appointment of Brett Mortensen as a Bylaw Enforcement Officer in accordance with Section 36 of the Police Act, for the purposes of the service of a summons and, as permitted, the issuance of tickets under the authority of Municipal Ticket Information Authorization Bylaw No. 7321.




